**Announcement of the Admission Criteria for Courses –  
MBA(Finance) and MBA(Business Economics) as decided by the Joint  
Admission Committee – Department of Financial Studies &  
Department of Business Economics**

---

**Final Selection for Admissions to MBA(Finance) and  
MBA(Business Economics) for the Academic Year 2020-21**

Selection of candidates is based on CAT (Common Admission Test, conducted by the IIMs), candidates' educational backgrounds and other criteria.

**CRITERION FOR FINAL SELECTION**

- It is decided that *waiting list* will be **FIVE TIMES** of the seats in each category for MBA(Finance) and for MBA(Business Economics).

**The Procedure of calculating the Composite Score:**

It is decided that the following weightage-system will be followed for final selection:

- CAT Score - *Weightage – 57.5%*
- Marks obtained in Class-X - *Weightage – 5%*
- Marks obtained in Class-XII - *Weightage – 5%*
- Marks obtained in Group Discussion - *Weightage – 7.50%*
- Marks obtained in Personal Interview - *Weightage – 20%*
- Candidates with the below-mentioned Graduate Degrees - *Weightage – 2.50%*
- Female Candidates - *Weightage – 2.50%*

Notes:

- The following courses/programmes will be getting an extra weightage as mentioned above.
  - B. Com. (Hons.),
  - B. A. (Hons.) (Economics),
  - B. A. (Hons.) (Business Economics),
  - BBE
  - BBS/BMS and
  - BFIA/BBA(FIA).
- Due to the extraordinary conditions and lockdown all over India caused by COVID-19, it would not be possible to conduct personal interview (PI) and Group Discussion (GD). Therefore, it is decided that every candidate will get zero marks for PI and GD.
- To scale up all the marks upto 100, a scale factor of  $100/72.5$  will be applied to all marks and this will not change the relative merit of the candidates.
- The following grading system is used for the marks obtained in class X, XII and marks in Mathematics.
