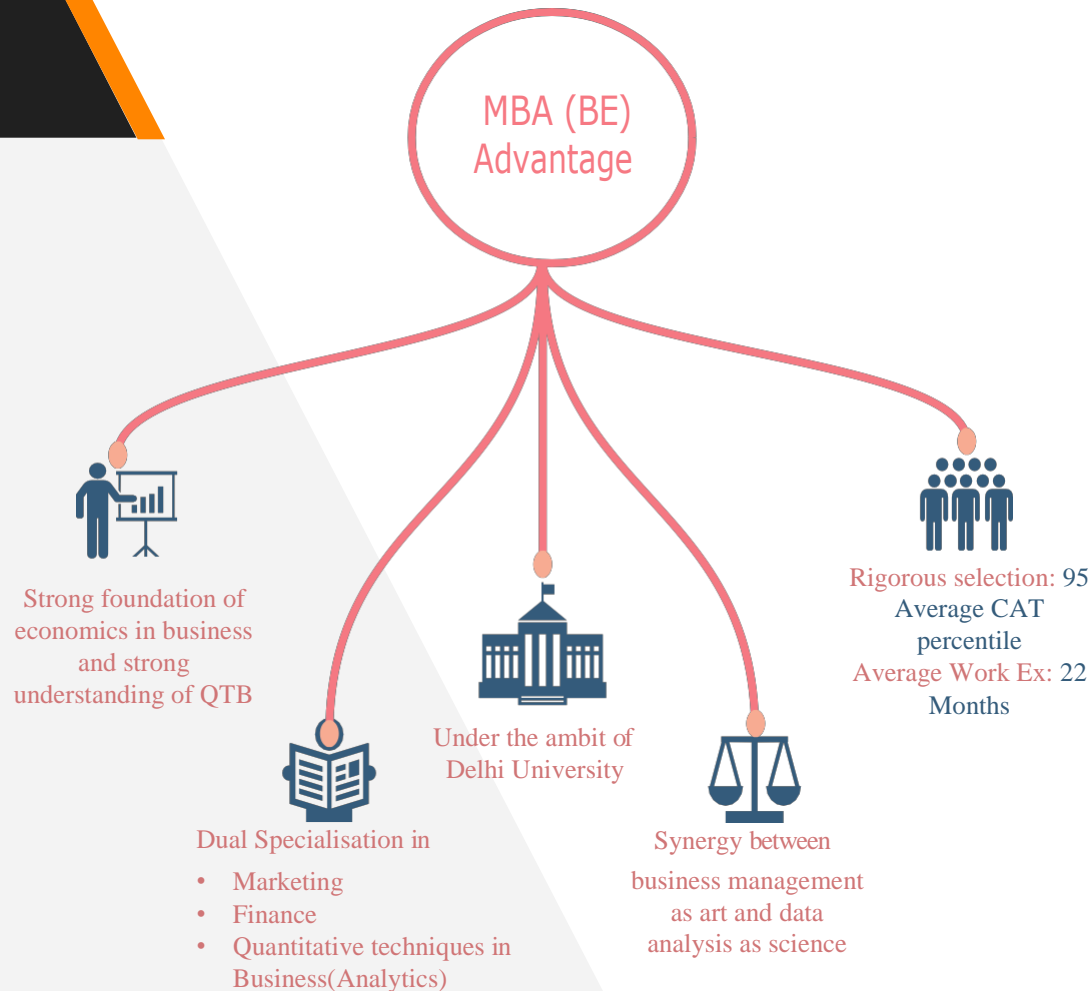

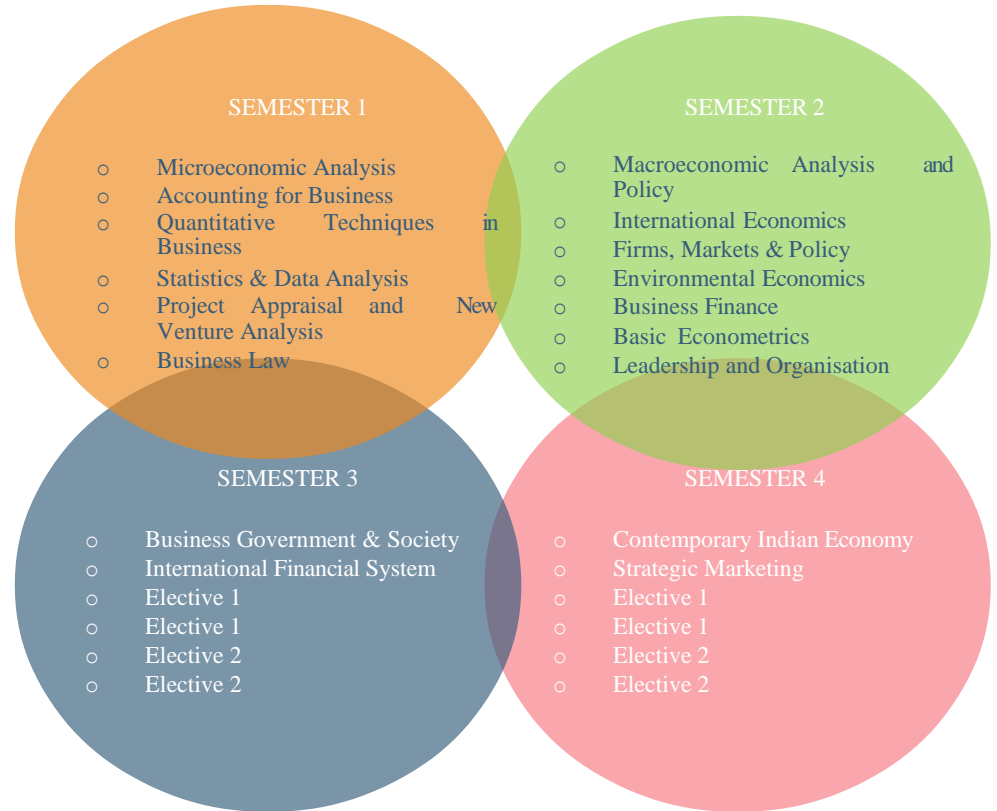

Course Curriculum

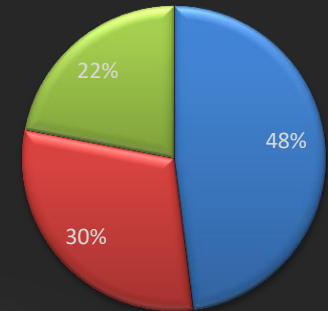
